

Section-II: Instructions to Bidders (ITB)

1. INTRODUCTION	
1.1 Scope of Bid	Gun and Country Club Islamabad (GCC) invites the "Proposals" under "Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure" from well-reputed, Tax Registered Firms/Companies, Original Manufacturers (OM)/their Authorized Distributors/Sole Importer and Supplier, having Income Tax and GST numbers with active status at FBR, for the Construction of Synthetic Running / Jogging Track.
1.2 Source of Funds	From GCC own funds.
1.3 Eligible Bidders	<p>i. The Invitation to Bids is open to companies/firms registered with relevant Registration Authorities and Tax Departments / Authorities (Income Tax, Sales Tax etc). JVs are not allowed.</p> <p>ii. Government-owned enterprises may participate only if they are duly/legally authorized in this regard by the respective / relevant competent forum/authority.</p> <p>iii. Bidders shall not be under a declaration of blacklisting by any Government department/ GCC or by Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA). During the Procurement Process / execution of the Contract, if the firm/ bidder is blacklisted by any Government department/autonomous body etc or by Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA), if such blacklisted bidder wants to execute the contract awarded after its blacklisting, the bidder/ firm shall provide 100% Bank Guarantee against the awarded Contract value and in case the bidder regrets to do so then the Gun and Country Club Islamabad may proceed with second lowest evaluated bidder.</p> <p>iv. 1.4 Eligible Goods and Services	<p>i. 1.5 Cost of Bidding	The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the GCC will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.																								
1.6 One person one bid	A Bidder shall submit only one Bid in the same bidding process individually as a Bidder

The Bidder is required to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the Bidding documents. Failure to furnish all information as required by the Bidding documents or to submit a Bid not responsive to the Bidding documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its Bid. iii. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad is not responsible for the completeness of the Bidding Documents and their addenda, if they were not obtained directly from the Gun and Country Club Islamabad's website. Re-Confirming from the Gun and Country Club Islamabad that all pages/contents have been properly and clearly received is the prime responsibility of the Bidder
2.2 Clarification of Bidding Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding documents may notify the Gun and Country Club Islamabad in writing or by email. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad will respond in writing to any request for clarification of the Bidding documents which it receives no later than seven (7) days prior to the deadline for the submission of Bids. ii. A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding Documents may notify the Gun and Country Club Islamabad in writing to provide record of the content of communication at the Gun and Country Club Islamabad's address. iii. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad will within three (3) working days after receiving the request for clarification, respond in writing or in electronic form to any request for clarification. iv. Should the Gun and Country Club Islamabad deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Documents as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under this document.
3. PREPARATION OF BIDS	
3.1 Language of Bid	The Bid prepared by the Bidder, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Gun and Country Club Islamabad shall be in English.
3.2 Bid Form	The Bidder shall complete the Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the Bidding documents, indicating the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the goods, their quantity, and prices.
3.3 Bid Prices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Bidder shall indicate the unit prices (where applicable) and total Bid price of the goods it proposes to supply under the contract ii. Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be item wise iii. Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-

	responsive and may be rejected
3.4 Bid Currencies	Prices shall be quoted in Pak Rupees .
3.5 Documents Establishing Bidder's Eligibility and Qualification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The documentary evidence of the Bidder's eligibility to Bid shall establish to the Gun and Country Club Islamabad's satisfaction that the Bidder, at the time of submission of its Bid, is eligible. ii. The documentary evidence, of the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract if its Bid is accepted, shall establish to the Gun and Country Club Islamabad's satisfaction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. that, in the case of a Bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the Bidder did not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' Manufacturer or producer to supply the same in Pakistan; If applicable b. that the Bidder has the financial, technical, capability necessary to perform the contract; c. that the Bidder meets the qualification criteria listed in the Bid Data Sheet
3.6 Bid Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Bid Security amounting to Rs. 500,000/- in the shape of Call deposit/Pay Order/Demand Draft in the name of Gun and Country Club Islamabad. ii. The bid security shall be in Pakistan Rupee
3.7 Period of Validity of Bids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Validity period of the bids shall be 90 days. ii. In exceptional circumstances, the Gun and Country Club Islamabad may extend the period of bid validity with mutual consent of both parties i.e. bidder and Gun and Country Club Islamabad.
4. SUBMISSION OF BIDS	
4.1 Deadline for Submission of Bids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Bids must be received by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad at the specified address no later than the time and date specified in the bidding document. ii. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad may, at its discretion extend this deadline for the submission of Bids by amending the Bidding documents. In which case all rights and obligations of the Gun and Country Club Islamabad and Bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended iii. Bids shall be received by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad at the address specified in this document no later than the date and time specified in the bid document. iv. Any Bid received by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad after the deadline for submission of Bids prescribed by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad will be rejected and returned unopened to the Bidder. v. No Bid may be modified after the deadline for submission of Bids vi. No Bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form. Withdrawal of a Bid during this interval may result

	in the Bidder's forfeiture of its Bid security (along with other remedies available).
5. OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS	
5.1 Opening of Bids by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad will open all Bids, in public, in the presence of Bidders' or their representatives, in the Bid proceedings at the place, on the date and at the time, specified in this bidding document. The Bidders' representatives present shall sign a register/attendance sheet as proof of their attendance ii. The envelopes of Proposals shall be opened at a time, and the following read out and recorded: (a) the name of the Bidder; (b) the presence of a Bid Security, and (c) Any other details as the Gun and Country Club Islamabad may consider appropriate iii. No Bid will be rejected at the time of Bid opening except for late Bids which will be returned unopened to the Bidder iv. Minutes of the Bid Opening shall be recorded and outcome of bidding shall be shared with the participating bidders. v. Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of Bids and recommendation of contract award shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the time of the announcement of the respective evaluation report in accordance with the rules.
5.2 Clarification of Bids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. In order to assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids and post-qualification of the bidders, the Gun and Country Club Islamabad may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid including breakdown of prices to determine its reasonability any clarification submitted by a Bidder that is not in response to a request by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad shall not be considered ii. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or in electronic forms that provide record of the content of communication. No change in the prices or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted
5.3 Examination of Terms and Conditions Technical Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad shall examine the Bid to confirm that all terms and conditions specified in the bidding documents have been accepted by the Bidder without any material deviation or reservation ii. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad shall evaluate the technical aspects of the Bid submitted to confirm that all requirements specified in this document been met without material deviation or reservation iii. If after the examination of the terms and conditions and the technical evaluation, the Gun and Country Club Islamabad determines that the Bid is not responsive as per requirements laid down in the bidding documents, it

	shall reject the Bid
5.4 Post-Qualification & Evaluation of Bids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad will determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily, in accordance with the evaluation criteria listed in this document ii. The determination will take into account the Bidder's financial, technical, and supplying capabilities as well as the previous experience of similar work. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder. iii. The Gun and Country Club Islamabad will technically evaluate and compare the Bids which have been determined to be responsive, as per Technical Specifications required iv. The financial evaluation of a Bid will be on the basis of form of Price Schedules and it will be decided by the Gun and Country Club Islamabad which must include clear cut instruction regarding item wise or package wise evaluation inclusive of prevailing taxes, duties, fees etc.
6. AWARD OF CONTRACT	
6.1 Notification of Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Minutes of the Bid Opening shall be recorded and final outcome of the bidding process shall be shared with the participating bidders. ii. The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract
6.2 Performance Guarantee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Within Fifteen (15) days of the receipt of notification of award from the Gun and Country Club Islamabad, the successful Bidder shall furnish the Performance Guarantee in accordance with the Conditions of Contract Agreement. ii. Failure of the successful Bidder to comply with the requirement above shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the Bid security along with other remedies available with GCC under the law.
6.3 Signing of Contract/ Issuance of Purchase Order	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. At the same time as the Gun and Country Club Islamabad notifies the successful Bidder that its Bid has been accepted, the Gun and Country Club will send the Bidder the contract form /purchase order, incorporating all agreements between the parties ii. The Gun and Country Club requires formal signing of contract, with the successful Bidder
6.4 Award Criteria	The Gun and Country Club will award the contract to the successful Bidder whose Bid has been determined to be responsive and has been determined to be the lowest evaluated Bid, provided that the Bidder has been determined to be qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily

6.5 Gun and Country Club's Right to Vary Quantities at Time of Award	The Gun and Country Club reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions.
6.6 Gun and Country Club's Right to Accept or Reject All Bids	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Gun and Country Club reserves the right to accept or reject all Bids or proposals (and to annul the Bidding process) at any time prior to the acceptance of any Bid or proposal, without thereby incurring any liability towards the Bidders ii. The Gun and Country Club shall upon request communicate to any Bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all Bids or proposals, but shall not be required to justify those grounds.
6.7 Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Gun and Country Club expects Bidders to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts ii. Blacklisting & Debarment: Blacklisted bidders and those found involved in Corrupt Practices" are not allowed to participate bidding, Requirements & Procedure for Blacklisting & Debarment will be dealt as per law.

Section-III Technical Specifications

1. General

1.1 Scope of Work

This document covers the technical specifications for the design, construction, and commissioning of an approximately **1250 feet (≈381 m) long and 8 feet (≈2.44 m) wide synthetic running/jogging track comprising two lanes**, including all associated **civil works, concrete base, and Polyurethane (PU) synthetic track system**.

The work shall include site preparation, earthwork, sub-base, concrete base slab, PU surfacing system, line marking, drainage provisions, quality control, testing, and final handover.

1.2 Applicable Standards

The work shall conform to the latest editions of the following standards, to the satisfaction of the Engineer / Club Management

1.3 Track Geometry

- Length: Approx. **1250 feet (381 m)**
- Width: **8 feet (2.44 m)**
- Lanes: **2 lanes**
- Lane width: Approx. **1.22 m each**

2. Site Preparation and Earthwork

2.1 Clearing and Grubbing

- Removal of vegetation, debris, loose soil, and organic matter from the track alignment.
- Disposal of unsuitable materials to approved locations.

2.2 Excavation

- Excavation to the required depth to accommodate sub-base and concrete base.
- Formation to be true to line, level, and gradient.

2.3 Compaction of Subgrade

- Subgrade to be compacted to **minimum 95% of Modified Proctor Density**.
- Any soft spots to be excavated and replaced with suitable approved material.

3. Sub-Base Construction

3.1 Granular Sub-Base (GSB)

- Thickness: **100–150 mm** (as approved)
- Material: Well-graded crushed stone
- Compaction: Minimum **98% Modified Proctor Density**.

3.2 Level Tolerance

- Finished sub-base level tolerance: ± 5 mm over 3 m straight edge.

4. Concrete Base

4.1 Concrete Specification

- Grade: **M20 (1 : 2 : 4)**
- Cement: OPC/PPC as per IS standards
- Aggregate: Clean, well-graded
- Water-cement ratio: As per mix design (max 0.45)

4.2 Thickness

- Nominal thickness: **100 mm (4 inches)** minimum

4.3 Construction Joints

- Expansion and contraction joints at suitable intervals (typically 4–5 m).
- Joints to be properly sealed and made flush with surface.

4.4 Surface Finish and Tolerances

- Steel trowel finish with light broom texture.
- Surface tolerance: **± 3 mm under 3 m straight edge**.
- Proper slope (typically 0.5–1%) for surface drainage.

4.5 Curing

- Concrete to be cured for a minimum of **14 days**.
- PU application only after achieving required moisture content (<5%).

5. PU Synthetic Track System

5.1 General

The track surface shall be a **Polyurethane (PU) system**, factory-produced, site-applied, seamless, elastic, and weather-resistant.

5.2 System Build-Up (Typical)

1. **Primer Coat**

2. PU primer compatible with concrete base.
3. Ensures proper adhesion and sealing of pores.

4. **Elastic Base Layer**

5. Thickness: **8–10 mm**
6. Composition: PU binder mixed with SBR rubber granules.
7. Laid by machine or hand-laying and mechanically compacted.

8. **Pore Sealer / Regulating Layer**

9. Applied to close surface pores and ensure uniformity.

10. **Wearing / Top Layer**

11. Thickness: **2–3 mm**
12. Composition: PU coating with EPDM rubber granules.
13. UV-resistant, non-slip, and abrasion-resistant.

5.3 Total System Thickness

- Approx. **12–13 mm**.

5.4 Performance Requirements

- Tensile strength: ≥ 0.5 MPa
- Elongation at break: $\geq 40\%$
- Slip resistance: Adequate for wet and dry conditions

6. Line Marking

- Two lanes to be marked using **PU-based or approved line marking paint**.

- Line width: 50 mm or as per approved drawings.
- Color: White or as specified.
- Markings to be true, permanent, and resistant to wear.

7. Drainage

- Cross slope: 0.5–1% to prevent water stagnation.
- No ponding permitted on finished surface.

8. Workmanship and Quality Control

8.1 Material Approval

- All materials to be from approved manufacturers.
- Technical datasheets and test certificates to be submitted.

8.2 Testing

- Subgrade and sub-base compaction tests.
- Concrete cube tests.
- Adhesion and thickness checks of PU system.

8.3 Tolerances

- Surface evenness: ± 3 mm under 3 m straight edge.
- No cracks, delamination, blisters, or loose areas permitted.

9. Protection and Curing of PU Surface

- Fresh PU surface to be protected from rain, dust, and traffic.
- Minimum curing time before light foot traffic: **48–72 hours**.
- Full use permitted after **7 days**, subject to manufacturer guidelines.

10. Maintenance and Warranty

- Contractor to provide **minimum 5-year warranty** on PU surface against defects in materials and workmanship.
- Maintenance manual to be submitted at handover.

11. Measurement and Payment

- Measurement shall be in **square feet or square meters** of completed track area.
- Rate shall include all materials, labor, equipment, testing, and incidentals required for complete execution.

12. Safety and Environmental Compliance

- All works to comply with local safety regulations.
- Proper disposal of waste materials.
- Use of PPE by all workers.

14. Drawing Notes

1. All dimensions are in **feet and meters** unless otherwise noted.
2. Track length is approximately **1250 feet (381 m)** and width **8 feet (2.44 m)**.
3. Finished track shall have **two equal lanes**.
4. Cross slope of track surface shall be **0.5% to 1%** towards drainage side.
5. Concrete base shall be finished smooth and true to line with tolerance of ± 3 mm under 3 m straight edge.
6. PU surfacing shall be applied only after concrete achieves required strength and moisture content (<5%).
7. No ponding of water shall be permitted on the finished surface.
8. All construction joints in concrete shall be sealed and made flush.
9. Colors of PU surface and markings shall be as approved by the Engineer/Client.
10. Contractor shall verify all site dimensions before execution.

15. Execution Methodology

15.1 Setting Out

- Track centerline, edges, and levels shall be set out using approved survey instruments.
- Benchmarks shall be established and maintained throughout construction.

15.2 Civil Works Execution

1. Clear and excavate the track alignment to required depth.
2. Compact subgrade to specified density and correct any weak areas.
3. Lay and compact granular sub-base to line and level.
4. Cast PCC concrete base slab in panels with proper joints.
5. Cure concrete adequately and check surface tolerances.

15.3 PU Surfacing Execution

1. Clean concrete base thoroughly and ensure dryness.
2. Apply PU primer uniformly and allow curing.
3. Lay elastic base layer (PU + SBR) and compact to required thickness.
4. Apply pore sealer/regulating layer.
5. Apply PU wearing course with EPDM granules using trowel method.
6. Allow surface to cure as per manufacturer's recommendation.

15.4 Line Marking

- Mark lanes only after full curing of PU surface.
- Ensure straight, uniform, and durable markings.

15.5 Inspection and Handover
